

Rules and Regulations for Return of Play

Please find below the new Rules and Regulations we as a club need to observe in order to maintain your and your family's safety and the safety of those who provide our venues.

All of the points are based on the latest information from Badminton England. These rules are being put in place to ensure that Beaufort Badminton Club complies with all of the latest instructions from both BE and the Government.

Please read the points carefully.

***If you or any of your household have symptoms, or if you have been told to self-isolate by Test and Trace or your doctor, please do not come to club.
Please follow the current advice to self-isolate for the allotted time set out by the government.***

Before you Arrive:

Be aware that the latest government guidelines have placed a limit on the number of players we can safely have on each club night. We will be doing all we can to ensure a fair distribution of club night slots, as well as keeping the safety of the members as our top priority.

- Members who wish to participate in club nights **must** have paid the fees for the upcoming season. If you have any issues with this, please speak to your section reps to arrange a solution.
- All participant slots will be organized prior to club nights. Please **do not** turn up to any club nights that you are not selected for.
- Please respond promptly to any communication regarding club nights.
- A waiting list will be set up for each section, please ensure you are aware what position you are on this list.
- If you do not feel well or are unable to come to a club night you have signed up for, please inform us immediately.
- If you are called up from the waiting list, please ensure you send confirmation that you will be attending.
- If you consistently do not turn up to club nights you have signed up for without informing an organizer, you may be subject to a suspension of club activities.***

Arriving at Club Night:

You will notice a few significant changes to club nights when you return. These are all in line with the latest guidance and may be subject to change as the situation progresses. Please be patient and understanding of the need for these measures to ensure your safety.

- All members will be subject to temperature checks on arrival. If your temperature is 37.8 or above, you will be asked to return home immediately.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided and **must** be used on arrival, as well as throughout the night.
- All members **must** sign in to confirm their attendance and compliance with the Rules and Regulations of Return to Play set out in this document.
- All members **must** adhere to any one-way systems in place at the venue.
- All members **must** continue to follow the social distancing measures outlined by the government.
- Failure to comply with the above measures may result in suspension from club activities.***

Whilst Playing:

There have been a few changes to play, ensuring that all members are staying as safe as possible throughout the night. The players will be split up, 6 per court, with dedicated shuttles for each court to avoid cross contamination.

- All members **must** stay within their allocated group for the duration of the session.
- Players who are not on court **must** adhere to social distancing guidelines.
- Hand Sanitizer is to be used in between each game.
- If a shuttle is hit over by another court, you must use your racket to return it, **do not** pick it up.
- You **must** refrain from any physical contact with other players (i.e. handshakes/high fives).
- Avoid touching the nets and posts wherever possible, if unavoidable ensure hand sanitizer is used before and after.
- All shuttles from your court **must** be collected and returned to organizer at the end of the session.
- Failure to comply with the above measures may result in suspension from club activities.***
